## INFORMATION

The American Statistical Association (ASA) and nine other organizations (including PAA and APC) have sent a letter to Rep. Carolyn B. Maloney (D-NY) endorsing HR 1254, The Restoring the Integrity of American Statistics Act. One of the provisions of Maloney's bill would remove the Census Bureau from the Dept. of Commerce and establish it as an independent agency. The letter also supports another bill provision that would create a fixed, five-year term for the Director of the Census.
